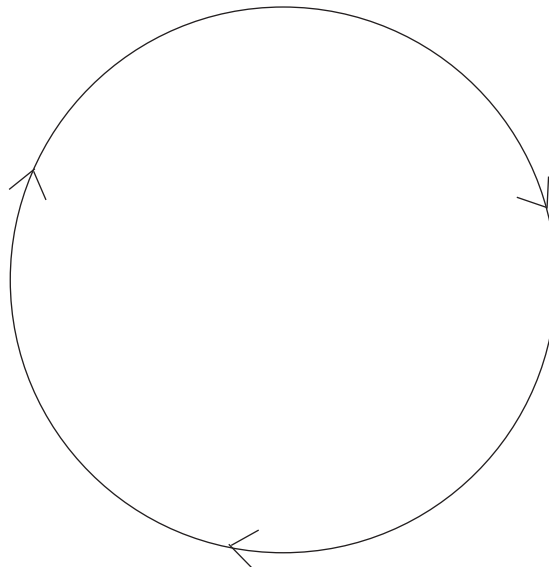

¹⁴ Now after John had been taken into custody, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God, ¹⁵ and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel.” ¹⁶ As He was going along by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew, the brother of Simon, casting a net in the sea; for they were fishermen. ¹⁷ And Jesus said to them, “Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men.” ¹⁸ Immediately they left their nets and followed Him.

Common Fears

There are four common fears we need to overcome in order to share the Gospel.

1. The fear of REJECTION .

Matthew 5:11

Is this person's ETERNITY worth my potential REJECTION ?

2. The fear of losing a FRIEND .

Would I rather lose a friend in THIS LIFE or lose a friend for ETERNITY ?

3. The fear that nobody's OPEN .

Matthew 9:36-38

³⁶ Seeing the people, He felt compassion for them, because they were distressed and dispirited like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. ³⁸ Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest."

Around 40 % of the students we meet are interested in hearing more about the Gospel.

Everybody's open SOMEDAY and somebody's open TODAY .

4. The fear of not KNOWING enough.

It's not about how much you know. It's about how much you CARE .

How to Set Up a Gospel Appointment

1. You can do this with friends and strangers!
2. Pick a **TIME**, a **PLACE**, and a **DAY**.
3. Get to know them and ask about their experience with **SPIRITUAL**
THINGS.
4. Share your story.
5. You can use the tool on Hope's website called, The Gospel Story, to clarify the Gospel.

the Gospel Story and to help them take the next step.
